OWNERSHIP

One and two bedroom homes with a 125 year lease are available (2006). A small number have a garden and conservatories. Residents would be responsible for the maintenance charge (utilities included, a small number of properties have their own gas supply which the resident is responsible for), ground rent and council tax.

Residents would be responsible to sell their property, although Beaumont Village can be requested to assist in this process.

Rental properties are provided on a short-hold tenancy for a fixed term of 6 or 12 months. A two-month notice is required prior to the renewal date if the tenancy is terminated.

The tenancy can only be terminated at the end of the current tenancy agreement. This is then extended annually.

To secure a rental, one month's rent in advance is to be paid. There is also one month's deposit which is held in a tenancy deposit scheme.

At the end of the tenancy the tenant/s are responsible to leave the flat as it was found.

Shorter respite/ holiday periods available, please enquire directly for availability.

RENT TO BUY

On a select number of property's it may be possible to operate a 'rent-to-buy' scheme, which enables you to move in immediately on a rental agreement, and continue with the purchase through the tenancy term.

This enables some (if they choose) to make the move to their new apartment before the sale is completed, and has proved very helpful for many owners as it can alleviate the stress in an otherwise stressful situation. It means that the purchaser decides when they want to move, rather than waiting for the sale to complete.

TENANTS

The monthly rent cost is as per individual tenancy agreement - \pounds 1425 - \pounds 1475 pcm Plus, service charge.

OWNERS

Owners pay a ground rent of £5 per month in addition to the weekly Service Charge and other costs.

The utilities are covered in the service charge the above rates are in respect to flats with and without their own boilers.

Please note materials not covered by warranty purchased through the Handy Man will be charged at cost.

Council Tax is variable within Beaumont Village and residents` responsibility. Please visit https://www.gov.uk to check your council tax band for your individual council tax band or contact Rushmoor Borough Council directly. **TV licence is residents` responsibility.**

INVOICING

Karis Homes Limited (Beaumont Village) invoice monthly for rent, service charge, ground rent, maintenance and guest room bookings.

Beaumont Care (Aldershot) Ltd will invoice for care & support, meal/food, housekeeping, and other variable support charges.

Care and support – Should you need and care and support it is your choice to decide which care agency you use. Beaumont Care (Aldershot) Ltd is an onsite care agency which is on site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, please contact the office should you require more information or to discuss your needs.

You will receive two separate invoices for Karis Homes Limited (Beaumont Village) and Beaumont Care (Aldershot) Ltd (care and support).

BEAUMONT VILLAGE - SERVICE CHARGE BREAKDOWN

Please ask for a breakdown of costs for the service charge available from the annual general meeting, held at the beginning of each year, if you decide to stay at Beaumont.

THE SERVICE CHARGE COVERS:

A site manager. Buildings Insurance. Emergency 'on-call'. Response required to all emergency calls made from flat owners at all times throughout the week. The provision of a village vehicle. Provision of lighting, central heating and hot water to communal areas. Sinking fund for major repairs. Up-keep of the communal areas. Communal Cleaning. General Maintenance. Professional Fees. Contingency. Handy man. Up-keep of the external elevations of the buildings. Communal Painting, Decorating, Repairs and Renewals.



ALSO THE FOLLOWING Maintenance contracts:

Telephone System. TV Aerial System (communal areas only). Lifts. Electrical contract including the gate to the site and CCTV cameras. Maintenance of fire alarm and associated fire equipment. Heating and lighting connected in communal areas and pipes.

External and communal areas window cleaner.
